

AGAIN LOCKED UP

Thief Picked Up As He Leaves Niagara County Jail

Robert Moynihan, 21 years old, who gave his home address as Syracuse, was arrested yesterday upon his release from the Niagara County jail by Captain Driscoll of the Pearl street station. Moynihan is to face a larceny charge in connection with the theft of a \$500 payroll from a safe in the battery shop of Deckop Bros. at 35 Goodrich street in 1921.

Moynihan, the police charge, went to the battery shop to have a battery charged. He requested permission from the man in charge to use a telephone. While using the phone, Moynihan is alleged to have reached open and to have taken the payroll from an open safe. He escaped. He was arrested in Niagara Falls for sneaking \$800 from a shoe store and sentenced to eight months in jail. He served it.
