

## JACOB LETTERMAN BECOMES BANKRUPT

Jacob Letterman of 912 Park st., manufacturer of cigars, filed a petition in bankruptcy in United States Court here to-day with secured liabilities of \$3,372, and nominal assets of \$5,809, of which accounts due him amount to \$4,415. Those accounts are owed by about 200 persons in Syracuse and Central New York and if paid would pay the bankrupt's debts. There are 25 creditors, those of Syracuse being: Martin Hiegster, with a claim for \$172; C. Schlossers Sons, \$24; Journal, \$75; Herald, \$28; and Mrs. J. Letterman, \$830. The bankrupt's lawyers are W. J. & L. E. McCluskey.
